We see this as a great opportunity for you to share in your child's education.

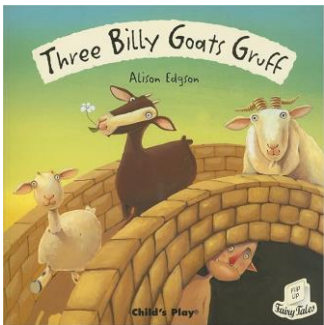
