ENGLISH

Our class text this term will be Rumaysa by Radiya Hafiza. This is an alternative traditional tale based on the story of Rapunzel.

The children will be learning to write an alternative traditional tale from a different character's perspectives. Within this, they will be focusing on skills such as using expanded noun phrases effectively and using dialogue to convey character.

Children will be learning about a new non-fiction genre: balanced arguments. They will be using their knowledge from history lessons to discuss whether the Sufragettes helped or hindered women to gain the vote.

RE

Five Pillars of Islam

Through discussion and role play, children will continue to learn what the Five Pillars of Islam are and why they are important to Muslims.

History

Crime and Punishment

Children will be learning about law and punishment and how they have changed over time. We will learn why the police force was introduced and different types of law enforcers.

We will be continuing to use Jigsaw to teach PSHE. This half term, children will be exploring how to deal with changes.

SCIENCE

This half term, we will be investigating how bridges are made and their structure.

Children will start with constructing tall towers, before moving on to exploring bridges. Next, they will look at animals as builders and finally engage in researching famous engineers and architects and the structures they built.

MATHS

This half term in Maths, children will be consolidating some of their existing knowledge, particularly their arithmetic skills, and applying this to new concepts.

Children will begin to learn about metric measures, and convert between units, and will learn about imperial measures too.

To consolidate their knowledge of number, children will be revisiting how to use division grids and multiplication grids. They will also be adding and subtracting negative numbers and working with decimals.

In Geometry, we will be learning to use a protractor to measure angles accurately.

Children will learn about meteorology and how to measure the weather. They will record weather patterns and use this data to create charts and graphs from databases.
