#### **ENGLISH**

In our Reading lessons, we will be reading a new story called 'The Good Thieves'. ### Art

### **MATHS**

In our Maths lessons, we will be focussing on reading and writing numbers up to eight digits and recognising the place value of each digit.

We will be calculating vertical addition and subtraction maths stories, including tricky columns.

We will focus on multiplying up to four digits by one digit and two digits, with up to two decimal points and divide up to four digits by two digits using the short method.

We will explore properties of 2D shapes and angles, calculate maths stories involving all four operations including vulgar fractions and mixed numbers with different denominators.
