Computing

We will be completing 'unplugged activities'. We will be giving instructions to each other to understand sequencing.

Literacy

We will be learning to recognise and pronounce sSet 1 sounds. We will be practising the formation of these sounds, thinking about how to hold a pencil with increasing control.

We will be learning to:

- Read with increasing understanding, this will include thinking about how characters feel or change throughout a story.
- Recognise and read sounds we have been learning in phonics. Please support your child by reading their reading book with them at home.
- Write our names more independently.
- Practise forming sounds we have been learning.

PSED

We will be settling into Reception, creating rules and routines together and thinking about how to behave in our new class.

We will be naming the different emotions that we experience, and ways to deal with them.

We have lots of new friends to make, so it is important we think about how to be a kind friend to others.

EAD

We will be using materials such as playdough, tissue paper, paint and building blocks to make simple representations of objects we see around us linked to the story we will be reading.

MATHS

This half term in Maths we will be focusing on:

- Counting objects to 10 and beyond.
- Recognising and writing numerals to 10.
- Matching number to correct numerals.
- Subitising to 5.
- More and less than an amount.
- Using positional language, on, under, next to, behind, in front.
- Using vocabulary to compare measures, big, small, bigger, smaller, same as.
- Continuing repeating patterns.

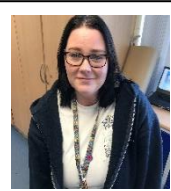

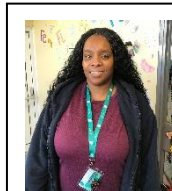
