We see this as a great opportunity for you to share in your child's education.

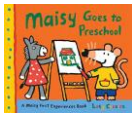

The children will be exploring different family members through this story. We will be talking about our homes and personal experiences. The children will even learn how to make a cup of tea.



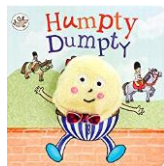
2nd October - 13th October

As autumn draws in the children will be exploring the changes in our environment. They will be thinking about night time animals through lots of fun and engaging activities.



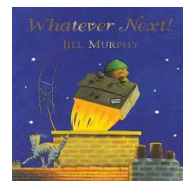
16th October - 27th October
