Our topics this term are:

The main books we will be reading are:











PSED

This term we are learning why it is important to listen carefully. We are also learning to follow instructions and places we might find them such as using a recipe.

FAD

The children will be learning observational drawing skills for drawing animals such as penguins, jungle animals. They will then create drawings for plants they have planted. They will also be using a variety of tools and techniques within their drawings.

We will be looking at what a recipe is and why we need to follow them. This will link to a deeper understanding of the need for instruction and why we follow them, developing our listening skills.

MATHS

This half term in Maths we will be focusing on:

- Counting objects to 15 and beyond.
- Recognising and writing numerals to 20.
- Matching number to correct numerals.
- Subitising to 10.
- More and less than an amount to 10.
- Comparing heights using vocabulary
- Composition of number to 10.
- Continuing repeating patterns.
- Adding using objects up to 10.

Literacy

We will be learning to recognise and pronounce set 1 sounds. We will then be blending sounds together to read a word and simple sentences, We will be practising the formation of these sounds, thinking about how to hold a pencil with increasing control. We will be learning to:

- Read with increasing understanding, this will include thinking about what type of text we are reading including fiction and non-fiction.
- We will be thinking about where we get information from.
- We will begin to recognise common exception words including 'the' 'to' 'I'
- Recognise and read sounds we have been learning in phonics, please support your child by reading their reading book with them at home.
