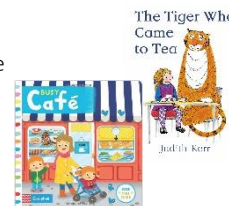


The Tiger Who Came to Tea

The children will be exploring different family members through these stories. We will be talking about our homes and personal experiences. The children will even learn how to make a cup of tea.

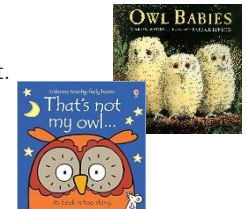


Owl Babies

The children will be learning all about different celebrations and festivals over these two weeks such as Bonfire Night and Diwali. We will be enjoying food tasting and dressing up.

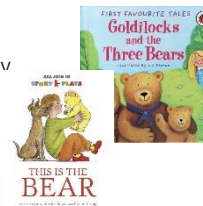


Goldilocks and the Three Bears
