Children will have the vocabulary to talk about summer weather and will know we need a sun hat and suncream to stay safe in the sun.</p>	<p>Past and Present Children will talk about somewhere they have visited with their family.</p>	<p>People, Cultures and Communities Children will recognise a zoo. They will know the name for some popular zoo animals. They will know how the animals are looked after by a zookeeper.</p>	
<p>Expressive Art and Design Key Knowledge:</p>	<p>Being Imaginative and Expressive Children will know how to create a pattern or picture using different materials for printing. Children will know the name of different materials and choose the best ones to create a collage. Activity: print and collage animal patterns.</p>	<p>Creating with Materials Children will know the name of some basic cooking skills (for example cut, chop, spread, wash). Children will have the vocabulary to talk about the ingredients and utensils they are using to cook. Activity: make sandwiches for a picnic.</p>	<p>Being Imaginative and Expressive Children will know a selection of nursery rhymes. They will have the understanding and vocabulary to make their own songs or change existing songs they know. Activity: learn 'Wheels on the Bus' and 'Tommy Thumb.'</p>
