Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to you to share a brief reminder about online safety, following conversations we have had in school with some children regarding online gaming, particularly the platform **Roblox**.

While many children enjoy Roblox as a creative and social game, it is important to remember that it allows users to communicate with others online, including people they do not know. Sadly, this means there is a risk of children being contacted by strangers or exposed to inappropriate language or behaviour.

We would strongly encourage parents and carers to speak with their children about the importance of **not communicating with people they do not know online**, and to remind them never to share personal information such as their name, school, address, or photographs. We also recommend checking privacy settings, using parental controls where available, and supervising online activity as much as possible.

In school, we regularly teach children about keeping themselves safe online and what to do if something makes them feel uncomfortable or worried. Your support in reinforcing these messages at home is greatly appreciated and helps keep our children safe.
